Volunteer Programs

Animal Exercising & Dog Walking

Volunteers work with animals to provide exercise and help continue and improve social skills in the animals.

Animal Grooming

Volunteers bathe and groom animals from the adoption floor before going to their new homes or as needed.

Health Care Specialist

Learn the art of keeping animals healthy (clean cages, clean hands, clean food containers, clean bedding, etc.) To accomplish this use the proper tools; bleach, clean cloths, high power hoses, anti-bacterial gel, etc.

Event Volunteer

Volunteers work on an as-needed basis before and during fundraising events. Volunteers may assist in preparation for events, which includes mailing, research, brochure distribution, etc. On event day, duties include set-up, decorating, registration, ticket booth, serving, etc.

Satellite Adoption

Volunteers will work at our off-site adoption centers. Volunteers interview potential adopters, process adoptions, care for the animals on site and distribute general information about AWL.

Greeters

Guide customers to adoption or redemption desks or clinic area. Provide information about procedures and policies to prospective adoptive parents.

Foster Care

Volunteers provide in-home care for animals that are sick or too young for adoption. AWL will identify animals that require foster care and will provide food and equipment to foster homes for the proper care of the animal. Foster homes are licensed by the Department of Agriculture and are subject to inspection by AWL at our discretion. Foster parents must complete another application and be approved by the director.
